SUPERVISED VISITATION AND MONITORED CHILD EXCHANGE

Sliding Fee Schedule for Standard Supervised Visitation

Intake fee is \$90 per parent/guardian. Court order or other agreement needs to specify who is responsible for payment of intakes and services.

Income	Fee Per Hourly Session¹
..... above \$80,000.....,	\$ 75 per hourly session
..... \$60,000 to \$79,000.....	\$ 70 per hourly session
..... \$50,000 - \$59,000.....	\$ 65 per hourly session
\$40,000 - \$49,000.....	\$ 60 per hourly session
\$29,200 \$39,000.....	\$ 55 per hourly session
Less than \$29,000.....	\$ 50 per hourly session
Indigent status	\$ 45 per hourly session

Sliding Fee Schedule for Monitored Child Exchange

Monitored Child Exchange is a documented exchange of children between the parents at neutral locations agreed upon by the parents. The Toby Center reserves the right to designate an appropriate location to assist client families. Court order or other agreement needs to specify who is responsible for payment of intakes and services.

FEES: Intake fee - \$90 per parent/party (\$180 for both parent/parties)
 \$39 per one exchange
 \$75 per dual exchange (i.e., weekend drop off and pickup)
