Sliding Fee Schedule for Therapeutic Supervised Visitation

Income	Fee Per Hourly Session
above \$80,000.....,	\$ 120 per hourly session
\$60,000 to \$79,000.....	\$ 115 per hourly session
\$50,000 - \$59,000.....	\$ 110 per hourly session
\$40,000 - \$49,000.....	\$ 100 per hourly session
\$25,000 \$39,000.....	\$ 90 per hourly session
Less than \$25,000 (and Indigent)	\$ 85 per hourly session

A separate intake/registration fee is required for each client family. The intake/registration fee is \$180 per family, or \$90 per party. It is recommended that all Court Orders and or other visitation agreements should specify which party is responsible for the fees. Fees may be allocated between the parties with specified percentages designated per party.

Therapeutic Supervised Visitation

Therapeutic Supervised Visitation is a form of supervised visitation, most often ordered by Court. This visitation is facilitated and monitored by a clinically licensed person as a therapist, mental health counselor or clinical social worker. Though not considered therapy, the efforts by the facilitating professional is to help parents and children through the challenges of visitation and frequently engage all parties including the custodial (at home) parent.

The value of therapeutic visitation is to help parents adjust to family change, to assist the children in their adjustment in relating to two different parents, and to enable the parents themselves to move forward by managing their anger, their stress, their conflict.

Therapeutic visitation is also helpful to foster children in reunification with their biological parents and to assist foster parents in their role as temporary custodians of the children.

Visitation occurs in neutral locations agreed upon by the parents and/or ordered by the Court. The Toby Center reserves the right to designate an appropriate location to assist client families.
