This fund will provide the money to enable foster children and others to have court ordered child custody services, such as supervised co-parenting, reunification counseling and family mediation! Why is this necessary? Because 35 percent of parents throughout Florida who call for Toby Center services have limited disposable income. They need your help!

This Scholarship is urgent, and based on the findings of the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS). The research shows that child outcomes are highest when both parents are engaged in their children's lives, the children demonstrate:

- \* Increased high school graduation rates
- \* Decreased teen pregnancy
- \* Lower incidence of alcohol and drug abuse
- \* Less bullying and more friendly behaviors

The Toby's Kids Scholarship Fund is in memory of David L. Levy, Esq., co-founder of the Children's Rights Council (CRC) and Alfred 'Al' Louis Ellis, who served as its Director of Child Access. Their testimony nationally brought shared parenting to more than 30 states. Together, Al and Dave created the largest, most successful network of supervised visitation locations in the U.S.. The Toby Center's founder, Dr. Mark Roseman served as Asst. Director for Child Access and has modeled the Toby Center service programs on his work and research.

Since 2008, the Toby Center has emerged as a dominant provider of child visitation and family reunification services in South and Central Florida for Family Court Cases and Foster Children.
